- An up to date CV and recent photograph
- Online application form, available on our website
- Contact details of two professional referees, one of whom should be your current Head of School.
- All applicants must be willing to undergo child protection screening, including checks with past employers. The successful candidate will be asked to provide identity verification, original copies of professional qualifications and an enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check or national equivalent (criminal record check.)

Recruitment Process

- Shortlisted candidates will be contacted by Friday 14th January 2022
- Selection activities including a Zoom interview are scheduled to place by 21 January 2022
